The Mechanics Local 701 Training Fund is offering members of Local 701 in good standing a preparation class to obtain an Illinois Class A Commercial Learners Permit (CLP). A Class A CLP is the first step in obtaining an Illinois Class A Commercial Drivers License (CDL).

Illinois Class A Commercial Learners Permit (CLP) Requirements

Illinois state statutes and federal law, enforced by the Illinois Secretary of State, Illinois State Police and U.S. Department of Transportation, require all Class A CLP applicants to conform to the following:

- ability to speak, read, write and understand the English language
- proof of US citizenship or Lawful Permanent Residency
- proof of Illinois residency and a valid Illinois drivers license
- certify conformance with federal motor carrier driving record regulations
- certify conformance with federal motor carrier medical condition regulations
- attained 18 years of age: to drive a non-hazardous load inside the state of Illinois
- attained 21 years of age: to drive any load outside the state of Illinois
- remit \$50.00 CLP testing fee to the Illinois Secretary of State
